Harpers Ferry for two months. I also lost my
speech about the same time; when I get cold
I can't speak louder than a whisper. I
have heart disease. I am ruptured and
have gone eyes.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 104; respiration, 18; temperature, 98 $\frac{1}{2}$; height, 5 feet 7 inches; weight, 122 pounds; age, 62 years. Tongue coated. Tongue increased area of hepatic dulness with tenderness on palpitation over hepatic and gastric regions. Jaundice. Disability - Found eighteen lbs. Also - Respiratory murmur, feeble throughout both lungs. No râle, crepitac or dullness on percussion. Expansion of chest 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches. Mucous membrane of larynx and vocal cords normal. No hoarseness or loss of speech at present. Disability - Found eighteen lbs. Also - Mucous membrane of pharynx red and congested. Mucous membrane of nasal passages red and congested. Septum slightly deviated to right. Disability - Found eighteen lbs. Also - No evidence of ruptures. No rating. Also - Heart action quick. Beats 104 per minute, standing and 124 after a brisk walk. No increased area of cardiac dulness. No râbles murmurs. Five teeth in lower and 5 in upper jaw. Clean them. Hair gray. Muscles generally flabby. Nutrition poor. Applicant has the appearance of a broken down man. Disability - Found eighteen lbs. 32
